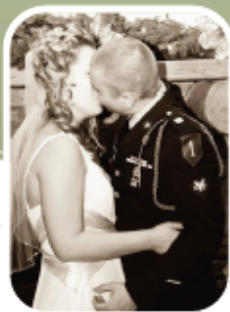


Sgt Brian Jergens

Sgt Brian Jergens, 23 years old was severely injured by an IED in Afghanistan on August 7th, 2011.

His injuries include the loss of both legs, the loss of his spleen and his wedding ring finger. He also had severe lacerations to most of his body, including a deep laceration of the neck that can best be described as a partial severing, which resulted in a broken neck. He also suffered serious fractures to both arms and major head trauma resulting in a Traumatic Brain Injury.

Brian has a cranioplasty scheduled for Jan 25th, 2012.
